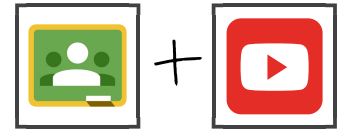

INTERACTIVE YOUTUBE VIDEOS IN GOOGLE CLASSROOM

WHAT ARE INTERACTIVE YOUTUBE VIDEOS?

- Engaging way to check student understanding
- Embed questions directly w/in YouTube videos assigned in Google Classroom
- Auto-pauses video at question points
- Offers multiple-choice, checkbox, and open-ended question types



STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

1. Create an Assignment:

- Go to Classwork tab
- Click "Create" and choose "Assignment"

2. Add YouTube Video:

- At the bottom, click the YouTube icon.
- Search for your video or select from "My video activities"
- Select the desired video.

3. Add Interactive Questions:

- Click "Add questions" at the bottom right of the video.
- Play the video and pause at the desired point for a question.
- Click "Add" below the video.
- Choose your question type:
 - Multiple Choice
 - Checkboxes
 - Open-ended
- Type your question and answer options (for multiple-choice/checkbox).
- Select the correct answer(s).
- Click "Save and continue."

4. Preview and Attach:

- Click "View as a student" to preview the student experience.
- Click "Attach" to add the interactive video to your assignment.

5. Complete Assignment Details:

- Add a title, instructions, due date, etc.
- Click "Assign."

BENEFITS FOR TEACHERS

- Access student performance data in Google Classroom.
- View correct/incorrect answers.
- Grade open-ended questions.
- Identify areas where students need more support.
